

## Bella Vista City Council Special Meeting Minutes – January 16, 2018

**Call to Order;** Mayor Christie called the meeting to order at 5:00PM

**Roll Call of council** was taken by City Clerk Jertson; Council members, Flynn, Bahr, Anderson, Fowler, Wozniak & Lloyd all present.

**There was one item of business:**

**R2018-01 RESOLUTION-** EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF BELLA VISTA TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM – ATTRIBUTABLE (STBGP-A) FUNDS FOR PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING AND ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE ON THE KINGSLAND ROAD AND HIGHWAY 71 INTERSECTION PROJECT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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This is for lights at the intersection at Kingsland & Hwy 71. The Mayor explained the reasons for the need for this traffic light. He cited the deaths and accidents that have happened at that location. The state initially denied the proposal. After requesting them to come to the intersection and get a better feel for the reason to do this project. After that visit they changed their mind and decided we could go ahead and try to get this done. The Mayor explained the timeframe of installing this light ourselves and paying the costs, or going for the funds in a conventional way.

Community Services Director Chris Suneson gave an explanation of this project and the tight timeline to apply for this potential grant.

After more discussion and Q & A. Council member Frank Anderson made a motion to approve, it was seconded by Jim Wozniak.

Roll Call vote was called by Clerk Jertson. Council members Bahr, Lloyd, Fowler, Anderson, Flynn and Wozniak all voted aye. There were no nay votes. Resolution adopted.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 5:17PM.
