**EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF BELLA VISTA TO UTILIZE
FEDERAL-AID SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM –
ATTRIBUTABLE (STBGP-A) FUNDS FOR PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING AND
ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE ON THE KINGSLAND ROAD AND HIGHWAY 71
INTERSECTION PROJECT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the US Highway 71 and Kingsland Road intersection has a large number of traffic accidents resulting in fatalities and property damage; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bella Vista has received correspondence from the Arkansas Department of Transportation indicating that the intersection of US Highway 71 and Kingsland Road has warranted a traffic signal;

WHEREAS, the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission has issued a call for projects to fund for federal fiscal year 2019 on a competitive basis;

WHEREAS, the City of Bella Vista City Council understand Federal-aid Surface Block Grant Program - Attributable Funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bella Vista City Council understands that Federal-aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained for the life of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bella Vista:

Section 1: The City of Bella Vista will participate in accordance with it designated responsibility, including maintenance of this project.

Section 2: The Mayor of Bella Vista is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the above stated project.

Section 3: The City of Bella Vista City Council pledges its support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas Department of Transportation to initiate action to implement this project.
