



BELLA VISTA POA AND ADEQ AGREE ON FINAL PHASE TO EXTINGUISH TRAFALGAR ROAD FIRE

(Bella Vista, AR) – The Bella Vista Property Owners Association (BVPOA) will take over the final phase of extinguishing the Trafalgar Road fire. The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) announced the decision after extensive discussions between the two organizations.

“Our intent all along in our discussions with ADEQ has been to find the most effective method to get this fire out as fast as possible. In addition, our approach has the added benefit of being more cost effective than other methods that were being discussed. We wanted to have direct control over the final phase to ensure the money we invest is well spent,” said Tom Judson, COO of the BVPOA.

BVPOA will employ three companies to put the fire out. ERM is a global firm that will provide engineering leadership on this project. The company has extensive experience in all aspects of environmental planning and compliance. A second company, E-3 Environmental of Mississippi, is the company that will do the actual work to put the fire out. CTEH of Little Rock is the third company. It is also nationally recognized in controlling and extinguishing large fires of all types.

“We applaud the ADEQ for cooperating with us and giving us the green light to get this fire extinguished. Our plan has proven experts behind it and they plan to put the fire out within 30 days or less following mobilization,” Judson said.
